In June 2006, Texas Department of Transportation began a 23-mile beautification plan along Interstate 10 from Loop 610 to the City of Katy. This development enhanced ecological resources along Interstate 10 and points of access along the highway on the north and south sides. Boyer aesthetically improved the highway appearance from Greenhouse Road to Mason Creek with more than eleven thousand (11,000) trees. A temporary irrigation was also installed to provide water to the trees for two years. Boyer Landscape Division will maintain the scope of work each month until January 2009.
